APPRENTICESHIPS

What level of apprenticeship should I look for?

Level 7 – Masters – e.g. in Accounting, Law etc. – 4-5 years of study

Level 6 – Degree apprenticeship – 3-4 years of study

Level 4 – Higher Apprenticeship - 2 years of study

Level 3 – Advanced – gives qualifications and experience in a role. 1 year – of study

There is a relevant apprenticeship for everyone, think about the level of study you wish to do when you leave Sixth Form. Some students want to do a Masters/Degree others prefer to work their way up in an organisation.
