

Applicant Interviews at Toot Hill Sixth Form College (2021): Frequently Asked Questions

If you have been invited to interview, please read the information below for further guidance and advice.

1. How will the interview be conducted?

Unfortunately, due to COVID restrictions, interviews will take place via a Microsoft Teams call this year. Once you have booked your appointment time and slot, you will receive a Microsoft Teams invite. You should accept this invite so that it is scheduled on your calendar and additionally make a note of the date and time. Please note that the invites may not be scheduled and sent straight away.

On the day of the interview, please ensure the following:

- Be prepared and ready to join the scheduled Microsoft Teams call 5 minutes in advance.
- Make sure you choose a quiet space, away from distractions.
- You may choose to join with video or without. If choosing to join with video, please ensure that your background is blurred.
- Whilst formal dress is not required, you are reminded that this is an interview and should dress appropriately.

If your parents do not give consent to a Microsoft Teams call which will be recorded, your interview will be conducted via a phone call on the number you have already submitted.

2. Who will interview me?

You will be interviewed by a member of either the School Leadership Team, or the College Leadership Team.

3. How long will the interview last?

The interview will take approximately 15 minutes.

4. What sorts of questions will I be asked at interview?

The interview is mostly a chance to get to know you and help you decide whether Toot Hill Sixth Form College is the right place for you. It will cover the following broad areas:

- Why you want to apply to Toot Hill College.
- Further questions about the information you included in your personal statement.
- Further questions about the reasons for your course choices.

- Read back through your application form, particularly your personal statement, to remind yourself of what you wrote.
- Think about your future career aspirations and how your course choices might help these.
